**HALIM PERDANAKUSUMA AIRPORT TEMPORARILY CLOSED, CITILINK DIVERTS FLIGHTS TO SOEKARNO-HATTA AIRPORT**

**Tangerang, 25 January 2022** – Citilink airline will temporarily divert flights to and from Halim Perdanakusuma Airport to Soekarno-Hatta International Airport starting 26 January 2022.

“The temporary transfer of flight operations from Halim Perdanakusuma Airport to Soekarno-Hatta Airport is in line with the Halim Perdanakusuma Airport revitalization program starting 26 January 2022, as a part of follow-up to the issuance of Presidential Regulation (Perpres) Number 9 of 2022 on Revitalization of Indonesian National Military Air Force Base Facility/Halim Perdanakusuma Airport,” said Diah Suryani, VP Corporate Secretary & CSR Citilink in Tangerang, Tuesday (25/1).

Citilink flights that will be diverted to Soekarno-Hatta International Airport are flights for the following destinations:

1. Juanda Surabaya International Airport (SUB)
2. Ngurah Rai Denpasar International Airport (DPS)
3. Silangit International Airport (DTB)
4. Kualanamu Medan International Airport (KNO)

While Citilink will be diverted some flight as follows:

1. Halim Perdanakusuma (HLP) – Blora (CPF) vv. flight will be diverted to Jakarta (CGK/Soekarno-Hatta International Airport) – Surabaya (SUB) – Blora (CPF) vv.
2. Halim Perdanakusuma (HLP) – Yogyakarta (JOG) vv. flight will be diverted to Jakarta (CGK/Soekarno-Hatta International Airport) – Kulonprogo (YIA) vv.

Citilink will disseminate the information on the temporary change of flight operations through website, SMS, email or Citilink’s social media thus the passengers will be well informed.
